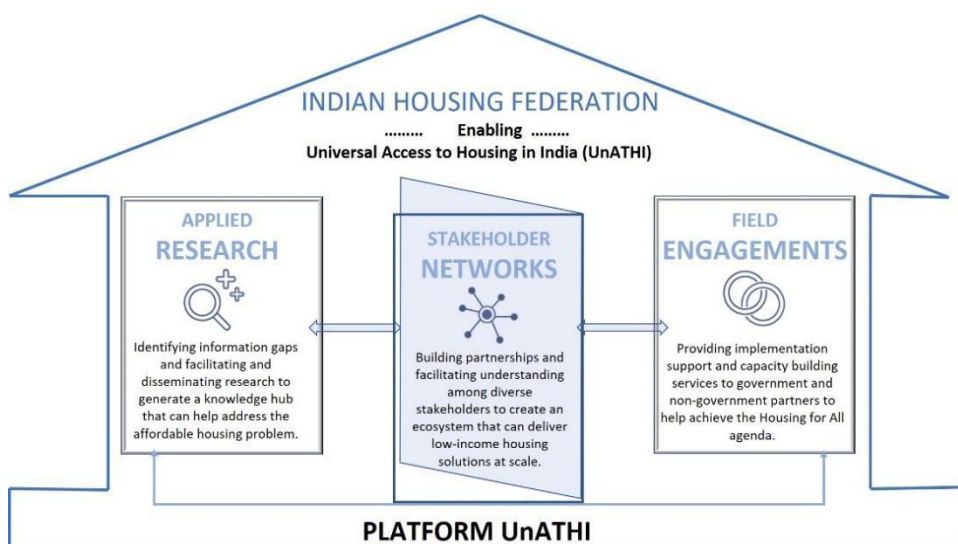


About IHF

Indian Housing Federation (IHF) is a Section 8 non-profit organisation with a vision to *reduce inequalities faced by socially and economically weaker sections of the society by enabling access to affordable and sustainable housing*. Incorporated in July 2015, IHF has accumulated over seven years of grassroots experience and understanding of the complex and diverse space of housing in India, while providing strategic and implementation support to the state governments of Assam, Haryana, Odisha, Tamil Nadu and Uttar Pradesh towards achieving the objective of “Housing for All”. Tata Trusts was one of the main early donors of IHF. Income tax exemptions for charitable activities are in place.

The Platform for Universal Access to Housing in India (UnATHI) is envisioned to become a multi-stakeholder discussion and action platform for inclusive and affordable housing, that will help build collaborations among government and non-government players, both for-profits and non-profits, to create innovative solutions for low-income housing, by working together and learning from each other.
