Key Requirements

- A minimum of 2-5 years of work experience in the WASH sector.
- Familiarity with the theory and practice of technical aspects of WASH, as well as policy-level and programmatic approaches at both the central and state levels.

Qualification

- A postgraduate degree in civil engineering/ environmental engineering/ environmental science/ urban planning or any related discipline.

Key Highlights of the Opportunity

- The candidate will be responsible for supporting the development, coordination and delivery of training programmes in diverse areas related to the technical aspects of water, sanitation and solid waste management in Tamil Nadu, across diverse government missions, including the Jal Jeevan Mission, AMRUT, Swachh Bharat Mission and others, along with multiple state-led initiatives.
- The candidate will work with multiple faculty members across different courses, and support them during and beyond the training programmes. This will include preparation of course material, identifying supplementary learning material, organising and coordinating field visits, monitoring classroom activities, and documenting the delivery of courses.
- The candidate will need to travel extensively across Tamil Nadu (for the Chennai-based position) and across different parts of the country (for the Bengaluru-based position) where training programmes will be delivered.
