India faces a twin challenge today - the era of a climate crisis and providing a life of freedom, dignity and prosperity for our young and largely poor population. Socratus wants to shift climate action in India from a peripheral, elite policy debate to an integral part of the policy agenda by integrating it with India's quest for a flourishing society. We believe that climate change needs to feature in every service in every domain and that integration has to be done in a citizen-centric manner.

Towards this, we create and enable spaces and tools for learning, designing and prototyping approaches to 'wicked' systemic problems. So far, we have experimented with two formats - Wicked Sprint and Citizens Jury - which are based on the Socratic method and participatory citizenship. We use tools that draw upon the disciplines of cognitive science, design, philosophy, arts and technology to host these and other spaces such as convenings and courses.

About The Urban Systems Lab

The Urban Systems Lab at Socratus is working at the intersection of Cities, Climate and Citizenship. Starting with wards in Bengaluru, over the last few months, we are expanding our scope of work to other cities as well as to urban environmental action and awareness at the national level.

By 2030, we want to experience a city where we live well together, despite the emerging environmental and climate challenges. This means we need to nurture citizen capacity for participatory city governance. In Bengaluru, we are currently running a project titled "Namma Ward Namma Dhwani" under which we hope to work with citizens, local influencers, and political leaders, to create a ward where all citizens can "live well, together". For us, the ward has become a location we can grasp in depth, where the moral complexity (citizenship) interacts directly with the material complexity (wicked problems) of creating a flourishing ward.



We are conducting this project in collaboration with <u>Flourishing Bengaluru Collective</u>. We expect to work in other cities and with the Ministry of Housing and Urban Affairs.

Role Summary

The Analyst is an integral member of the team and is involved in wide and varied tasks to make the Urban Systems work of Socratus possible. This will include working with partners, organizing workshops and convenings, basic research and other administrative and organizational support.
