About the Project

Since the early 2010s, the Government of Odisha has been proactively taking initiatives to enhance the water supply and sanitation situation in the State, especially in the Urban Sector. In addition to leveraging national missions such as AMRUT (both 1.0 and 2.0), the State has established schemes such as BASUDHA to operationalize the aspirations related to water supply and sanitation management. The State has made rapid strides in the last few years in achieving universal coverage for water supply and sanitation (sewered and non-sewered). In early 2021, Puri City in Odisha became the first city in the country to provide continuous assured quality of water to its residents, including those living in slum settlements. WATCO has undertaken (undertaking) DFT scheme in 24 ULBS.

From Feb 2023, a project "Institutionalizing an Impact Assessment Framework for Drink from Tap Mission *in Odisha*" is commencing. The overall objective of the project is to develop a tool for evaluating the impact of the Drink From Tap Mission from multiple

perspectives (water resources, system efficiency, service delivery, financial viability, etc), and apply this tool in 24 ULBs across Odisha. The project will provide insights on the impact created by the mission, as well as highlight key issues and challenges that may have a bearing on the long-term sustainability of the Mission.

Project Associate Responsibilities

The Project Associate shall carry out the responsibilities listed below:
