### **About the Project**

Since the early 2010s, the Government of Odisha has been proactively taking initiatives to enhance the water supply and sanitation situation in the State, especially in the Urban Sector. In addition to leveraging national missions such as AMRUT (both 1.0 and 2.0), the State has established schemes such as BASUDHA to operationalize the aspirations related to water supply and sanitation management. The State has made rapid strides in the last few years in achieving universal coverage for water supply and sanitation (sewered and non-sewered). In early 2021, Puri City in Odisha became the first city in the country to provide continuous assured quality of water to its residents, including those living in slum settlements. The Mission is being implemented in 24 ULBs, and there are plans to scale up the mission to all 114 ULBs in Odisha.

To ensure the smooth implementation of DFT schemes during scaling up, NIUA and WATCO are engaged in developing a Standard Operating Procedure (SOP) that provides clear directions on the steps that the ULBs should follow based on the learnings of the implementation of DFT

schemes thus far. The SOP will be a detailed document outlining the foundational steps and process involved in setting up a state-of-the-art Drink from Tap (DFT) initiative.

The overall objective of the project is to build an SOP that covers aspects ranging from policy framework, tendering process, approval mechanism, financial outlay, behavioural sensitisation, international best practices, etc., thereby creating a clear, articulate and comprehensive SOP that facilitates the smooth implementation and monitoring of DFT schemes in different ULBs. The SOP will be further hosted on a digital platform and presented in an easy-to-understand and visually appealing manner.

## **Project Associate Responsibilities**

The Project Associate shall carry out the responsibilities listed below:

- Conduct research on phase-wise implementation of Drink from Tap (DFT) scheme in Odisha
- Support data collection from WATCO on parameters related to the process of establishing and monitoring DFT
- Organize and manage databases containing collected data/information from WATCO
- Serve as a liaison with the Water Corporation of Odisha (WATCO) for day-to-day operational support.
- Support in research, analysis and development of the SOP and documenting best practices in the field of 24\*7 water supply schemes across the world
- Support in developing the visual design for the SOP to be hosted on a digital platform
- Support in preparing content for capacity building and training programmes organized for different stakeholders
- Provide logistical support to the team for conducting key events (e.g. workshops, review meetings etc.)
- Carry out any other additional tasks assigned

#### **Required Qualification, Work experience and Competencies**

- Post graduate (Masters) qualification in Environmental Planning/Management,
  Water Resources Management, Urban Planning/Management, Civil engineering,
  Environmental Engineering, or related disciplines from a reputed university/institute.
- 1-3 years of relevant professional experience in urban environmental planning and implementation projects.
- Excellent writing and communication skills in English. Proficiency in Odia language will be given preference.
- Strong inclination for documentation and developing knowledge products.
- Strong inter personnel and co-ordination skills, working independently, and flexibly.
- Willingness to travel to the project locations across Odisha as required.
